BRIEFING NOTES

- 1) Statement of figure to be made out of metal... (Image shows a dark, textured, bird-like head profile.)
- 2) The material to be used with steel... (Image shows a dark, textured, bird-like head profile.)
- 3) The material "model" will then have a rubber mold made from it.
- 4) A wax "model" will be made from the rubber mold... (Image shows a dark, textured, bird-like head profile.)
- 5) The wax is put in the "die"... (Image shows a dark, textured, bird-like head profile.)
- 6) When the shell is heat enough, machine heated in second take the shell and captures the wax... (Image shows a dark, textured, bird-like head profile.)
- 7) When the process has been (almost) completed, the investment shell is broken away from the brass.
- 8) The process is then "cleaned"... (Image shows a dark, textured, bird-like head profile.)
- 9) The part is polished... (Image shows a dark, textured, bird-like head profile.)
- 10) It is then polished... (Image shows a dark, textured, bird-like head profile.)
- 11) The sculpture is then used and is in a finished bronze figure.

Now: Once these are two sculptures to be made and sent, after the first model is made from the wax "model" (2), the second sculpture can be started immediately... (Image shows a dark, textured, bird-like head profile.)
